

#### Health v8 2050

#### Consumers as CEO's of their health!

Data, biomarkers, images about ourselves everyday, quantitative physicals

Care fully personalized to "one", not for the "average"

Predict cancer or disease; predict food/supplement optimization

Al physicians: primary care, psychiatrist, oncologist, cardiologist,...

Obsolescence of symptom based diagnosis (except trauma?)

Healthcare will be affordable, accessible, & better quality, on our terms

# Innovation Axes: "Practice of Medicine" to "Science of Medicine"

Al 24/7 "almost free" physicians...

data driven personalized care: 30k not 30 longitudinal biomarkers

"omics medicine" & imaging replacing symptom based medicine

new tools: CRISPR, DNA/RNA, microbiome

Al based Imaging, image diagnosis, enhancement, new imaging modalities

Al enhancement for tools (imaging, drug discovery, diagnosis, surgical robots...)

Accessibility, immediacy, affordability... the great equalizer

CRISPR organs, 3D printed organs/parts, microrobots,

....mostly new, unanticipated stuff!!!

### Transportation v8 2050 Carbon minimal, accessible, pervasive, public!

Autonomous public transit (point to point) with autonomous-only roads in cities

City transit \$1 point to point (no fixed routes public transportation) in 200lb pods

Trains replaced by on-demand 2-6 person autonomous "pods"; hyperloops for distance?

Flying taxis, autonomous aircrafts, and rocket ships to China?

People travel "time": range/land for "30 minute commute" housing will increase, decreasing parking lots & freeing up space

#### Tools and Axes of Innovation

Robotics

Electrification

Al and computer vision, radar, lidar,...

3D metal printing, 3D composites printing, 3D new materials

New materials & configurations, software design & testing

....mostly new, unanticipated stuff!!!

### Housing, Construction, Cities v8: 2050 Dematerlized, dense, efficient carbon minimal!

Densification & dematerialization of city environments: more virtual SW based services

Enhanced services: transportation, food, furniture, sharing/social

Dematerialized services: medical, education, shopping, entertainment, exercise, social/sharing... @home, SW

Reuse of space, robotic delivery, robotic kitchens, mostly public transit

Larger commuting distance "within 30 minutes"

Freed up parking = space for parks/communities/housing; elimination of 80% of cars

Rethinking city design in more sustainable, more affordable, more efficient way

#### Axes of Innovation

Reconfigurable interiors: "transformer" furniture with robotics & sharing (WeWork/AirBnB)

Al/Generative design for optimization; factory manufacturing, CNC/3D printing

Autonomous sensors dynamically provisions energy, security, health monitoring & services

Rethinking of materials: New materials & smaller material amounts; composites, polymers, ...

Shared and fractional ownership

Larger commuting distance with new transportation innovation

### Manufacturing v8: 2050 Dematerialized, efficient, just in time, diverse local!

Dematerialized designs; generative designs; composites; new materials

Short supply chains; changing warehousing/supply configurations

More customized, more local "just-in-time" 3D printed/assembled products & smaller inventories

Robotic assembly line workers & delivery/assembly/warehousing/supply robots

Automated just in time warehouses multiply space 10X through frequent ordering

Generative design

3D metal, composites, investment casting

Robotics

Al-based design and verification; Virtual testing of products

Computational design of materials

New materials

Blockchain based supply chains

Revenge of shitty robots (cheaper less precise robots augmented by AI)

Arevo: True 3D printed Composites & software design/testing/QA


Velo3D: "Impossible metal parts" manufacturing for design freedom

DDM: 3D printed investment casting; ceramic 3D; ceramic parts

Digital Alloys: very low cost 3D metal wire based printing

Carbon: Polymer printing

#### Food & Ag v8: 2050

Better, less land, chemicals & resources, less factory!

Future of food: less cost, less environmental impact, quality

Reduce impact of meat production

Reduce chemical input

Optimize land use; create local specialize farming (vertical?)

Rethink supply chain efficiency (local)

De-carbonize, de-nitrifiy, de-land, de-chemical, de-factory food chain

Reinventing Food: Eggs, dairy, insects, inedible proteins ...

Robotics for plant by plant care/chemicals/fertilization/water

Al for imaging and data analysis, space

Transportation decarbonizing


Decarbonization of food
